For ALL <u>School Employees</u> and <u>Contractors</u> From ANY School in Bucks County*

Bucks County is providing a FREE COVID-19 testing program for school employees and contracted staff* (this is not open to the public, students are not eligible). Specially trained staff will be administering Rapid Tests. You need not disclose any reason for wanting a test and you will be provided with the results while on-site. Individuals must bring their current, official, school-issued photo identification in order to be tested (personnel without this official school-issued identification will not be tested).

Your test results are confidential and will not be shared with your employer school.

Individuals can use the dated <u>negative test result</u> they receive on-site, in conjunction with the date they returned from travel or their last date of exposure, to be released from quarantine.

<u>If an individual tests positive</u>, staff will do a secondary (non-Rapid Test) to confirm the results (this will take another 20-30 minutes). If the second test is also positive, the individual will need to immediately call their school employer as per their employer's protocols and follow the process outlined by their school's Health and Safety Plan.

* Eligible personnel will be staff and contracted staff working at any and all public, private, parochial, nonpublic, and independent schools as well as preschools, and daycares located within Bucks County PA. Individuals must bring their current official school-issued photo identification in order to be tested. This is not open to the public. Students are not eligible.
