The Pennsylvania Youth Survey (PAYS) asks questions about youths' thoughts of their school environment, plus their knowledge and attitudes towards alcohol, tobacco, other drugs, violence, mental health, and more. The survey happens once every other year in 6th, 8th, 10th, and 12th grades across Pennsylvania.
