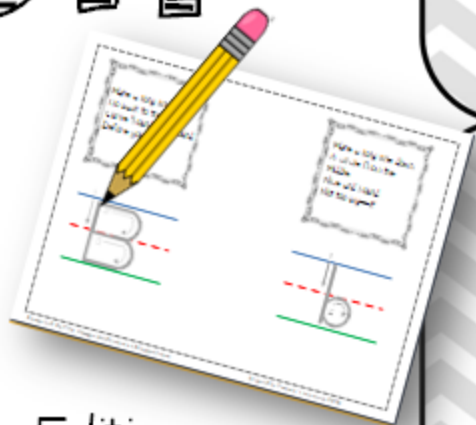


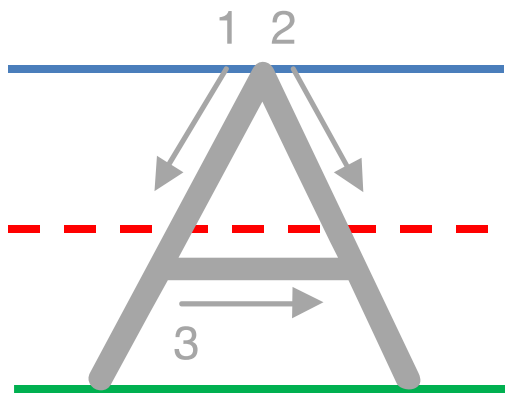

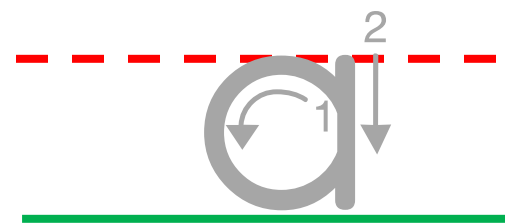

From Maggie at Maggie's Kinder Corner

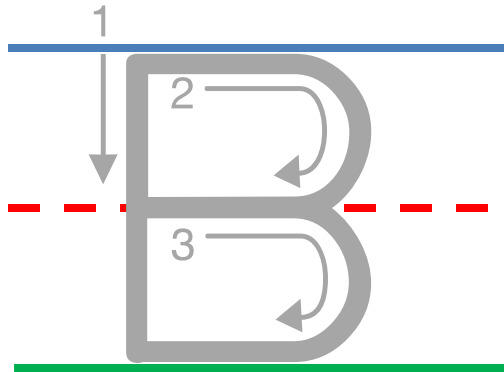
Start at the Top, slant

Middle.



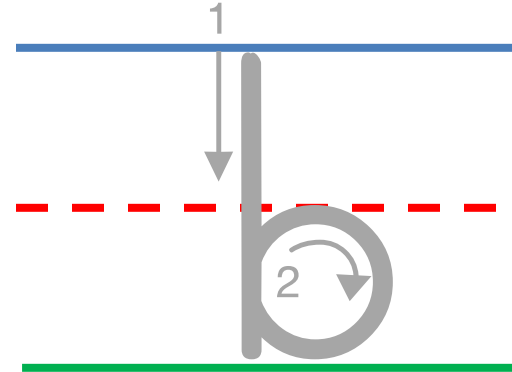
Start in the middle,

down.



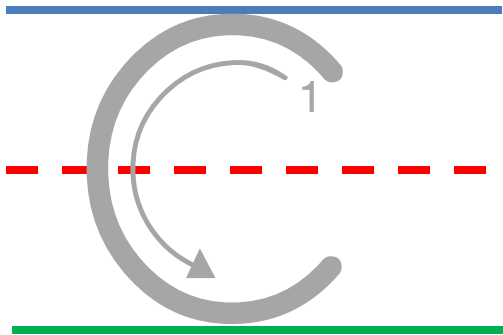
Make a long line down.

Before you stop!



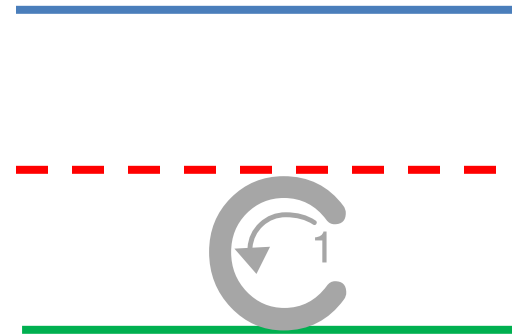
Make a long line down.

Not too big—it'



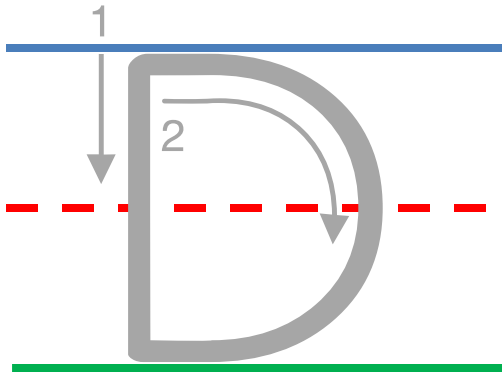
Slant near the top line.

Nice and round.



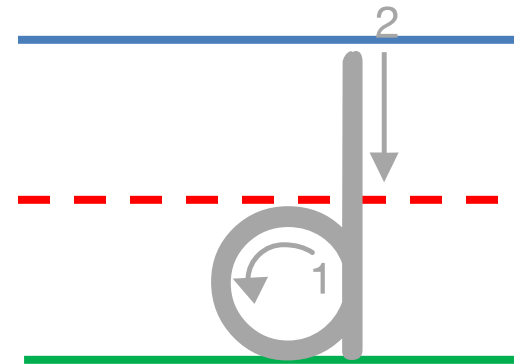
Start near the middle
line.
Curve around.
Leave the circle open,
But nice and round.



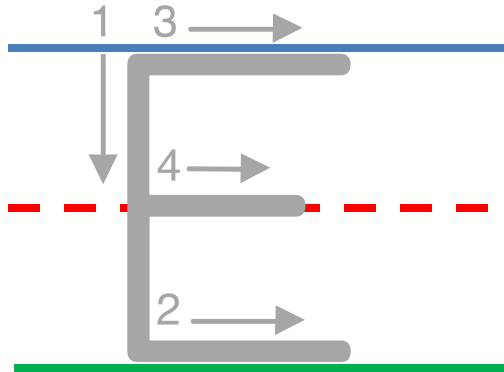
Big D starts with a
Long line down.
Go back to the top
And curve all the way
around:
It's a D, a big D!



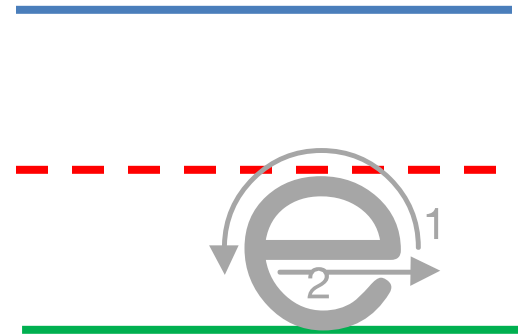
Start in the middle,
Make a circle nice and
Round.
Go up to the top and
Come straight down:
It's a d, a small d!



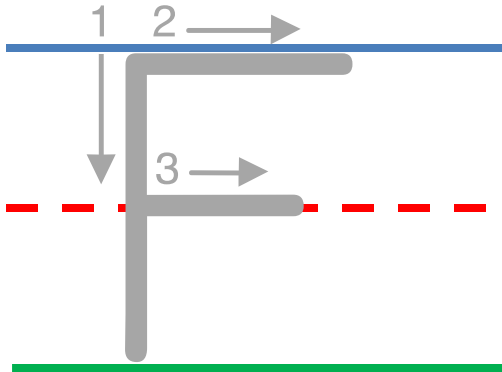
Make a tall straight line,
Then three lines to the
side: top, middle, bottom
your big E looks fine!



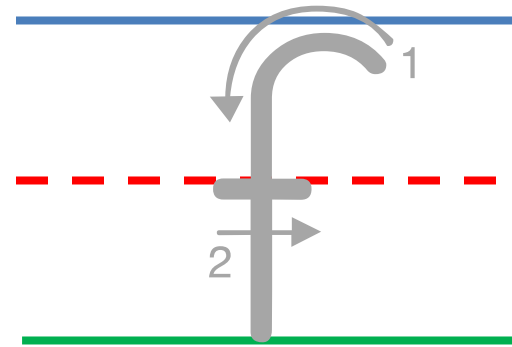
Go straight across the
middle, then up and
around..
Leave the circle open,
but keep it nice and
round.



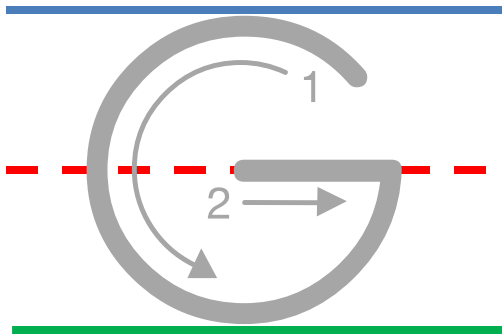
Start at the top and
Make a tall, straight
line.
Make a line to the side.
Do it one more time.



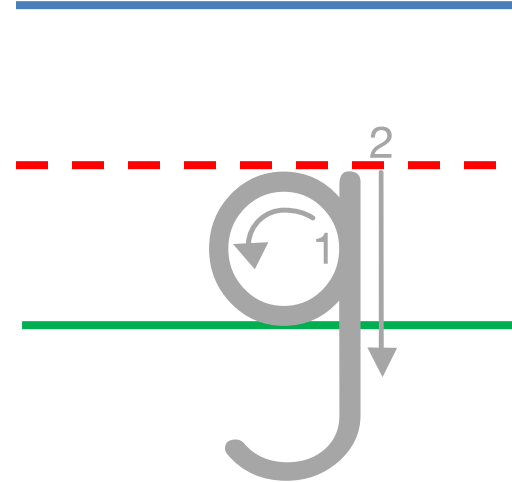
Start at the top, curve
Round and drop.
Cross the line in the
Middle and then you'll
stop.



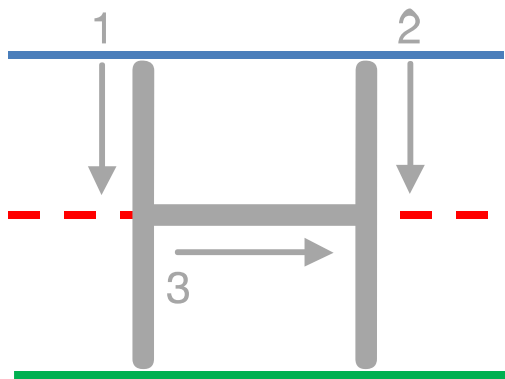
Start at the top and
Curve left like a
Capital C. Add a
Short line in the middle
To make capital G.



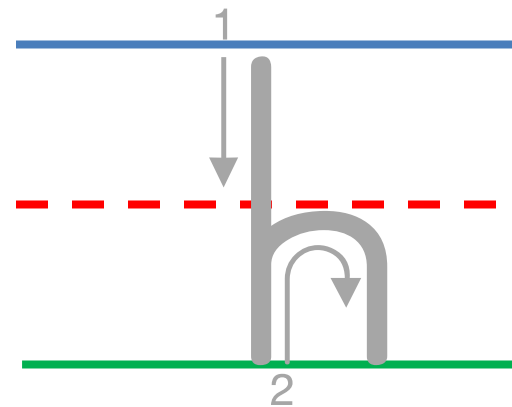
Make a small circle in
The middle, just a little
Hoop. Go straight
down by the circle and
End with a scoop.



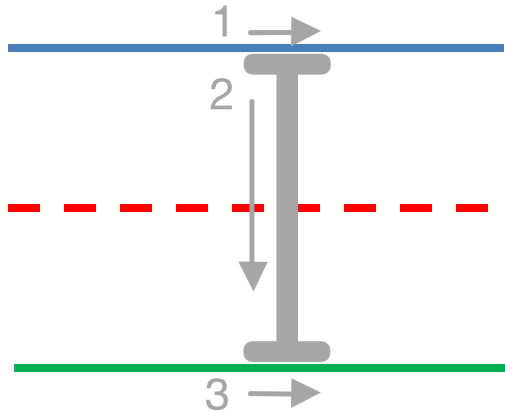
Two tall lines standing
Next to each other.
Connect them at the
Middle.
They hold hands with
each other.



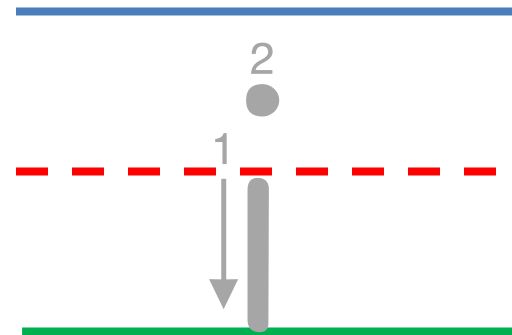
One straight tall line
And a curvy little bump
Makes a hook like
A little camel's hump.



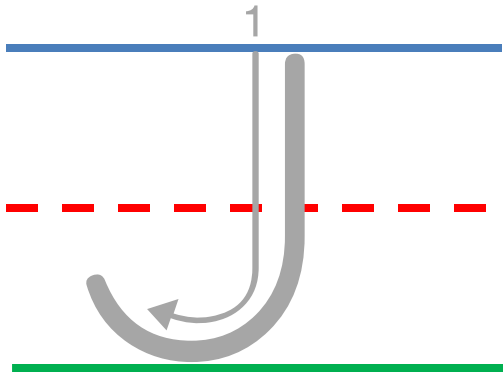
Make a long line down
Then back up top you go
Make a short line across
And another down below.



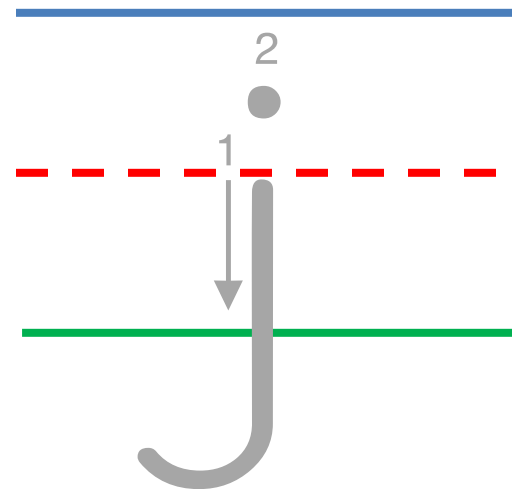
Straight down for small i
And then you stop.
Now put a dot right on
Top.



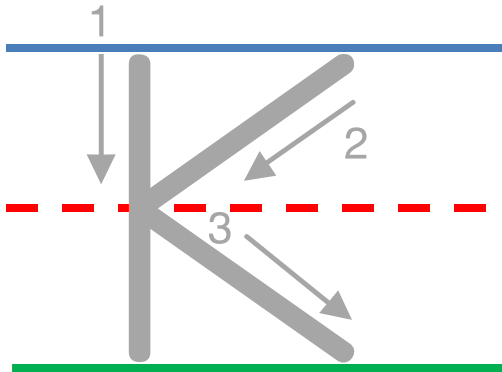
Down from the top,
Then a short curve.
Bring it up a little,
Just a little swerve:
It's a J, big J, big J!



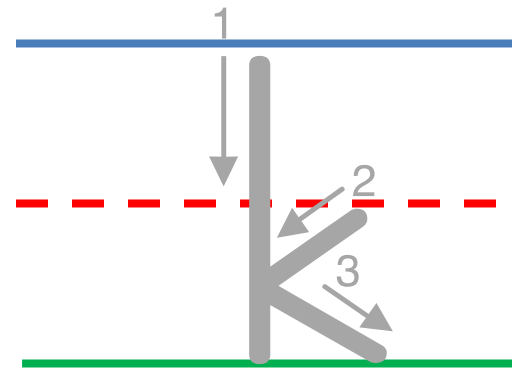
Small j has
Just one line down.
Curve up a little,
Add a dot as a crown:
It's a j, small j,
small j!



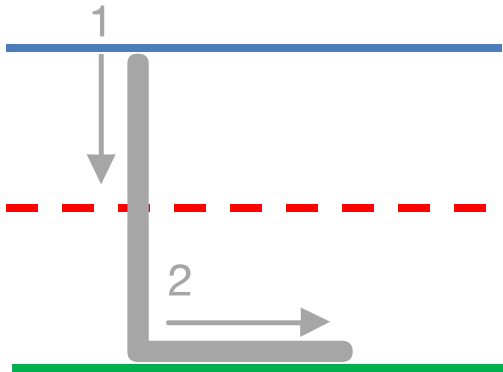
Make one line,
A tall straight stick.
Add one arm in a
Wave and one leg in
A kick:
That's K, big K, big K!



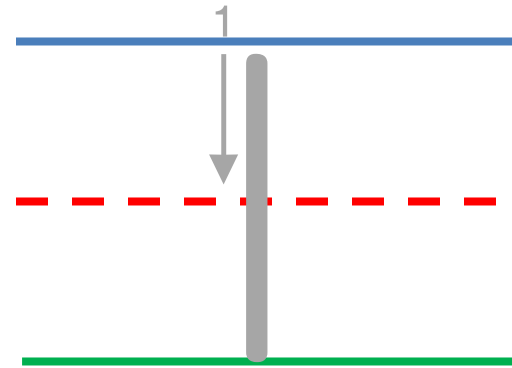
Make one line,
A tall, straight stick.
Now add a little wave
And a little kick:
That's a k, a small k,
A small k!



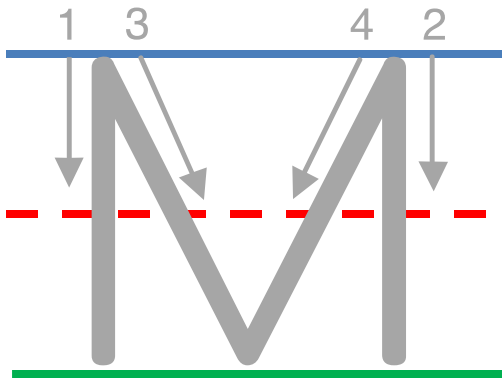
Make a tall, straight
Line that you start at
The top.
Come down to the
Bottom, go out,
And stop.



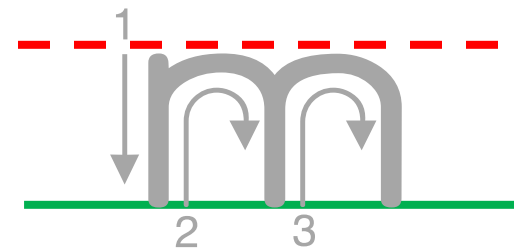
Small l
Looks like a stick.
Just one straight line.
It's easy and quick.



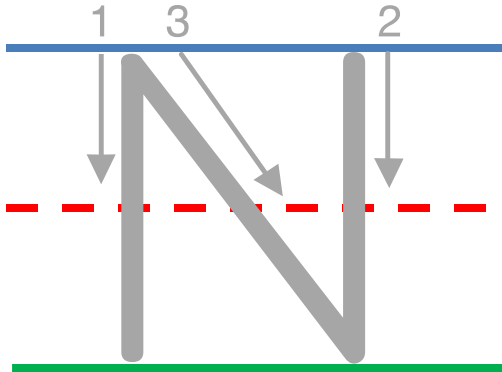
Make a line going
Down. Then two lines
That meet.
One more, you're done.
It's very neat.



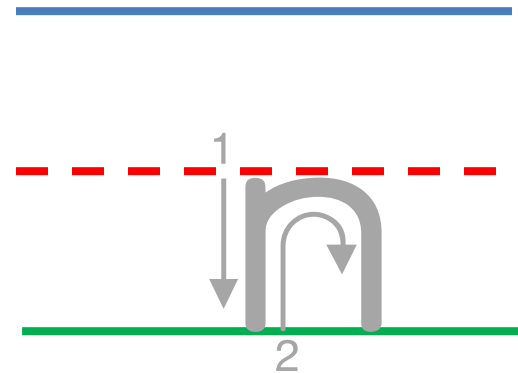
Little m is short
Start in the middle.
Make two little hills.
It's not a riddle.



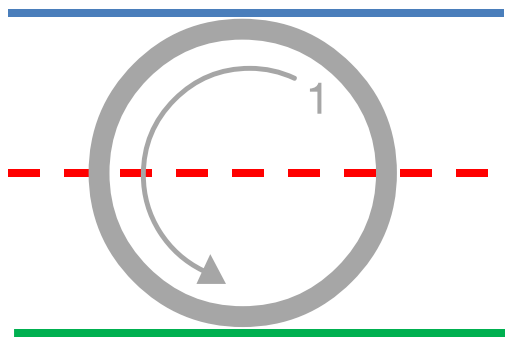
A line that goes down.
Then a slide to the
Side.
One more line up.
Big N, we cried!



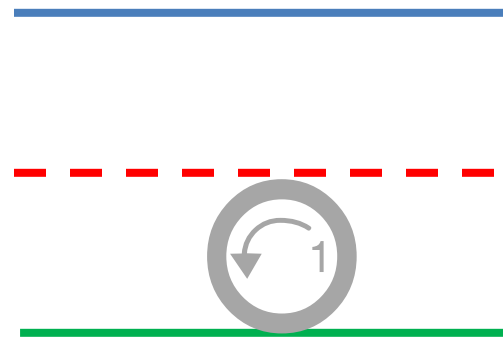
Little n is short.
One line down at the
Start.
Then one little hill
That's the fun part.



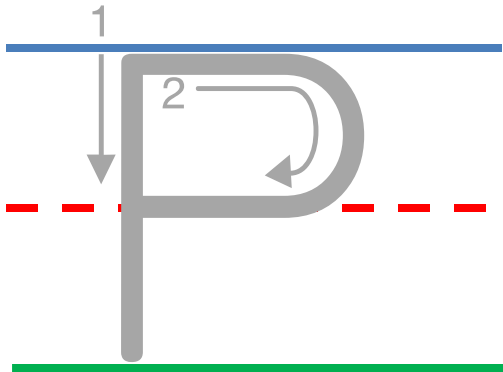
Start near the top line,
and curve around.
Make a circle, nice and
round.



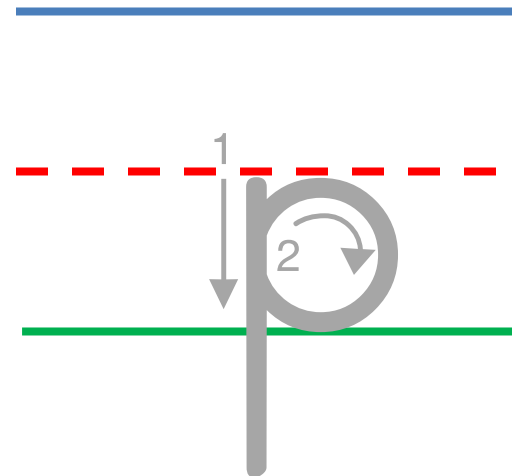
Start in the middle to
Make small o.
Curve around in a
circle, go nice and
slow.



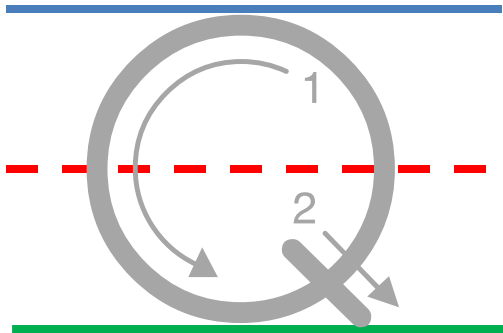
Start at the top and
Make a long line down.
Go back to the top
And circle half-way
Around.



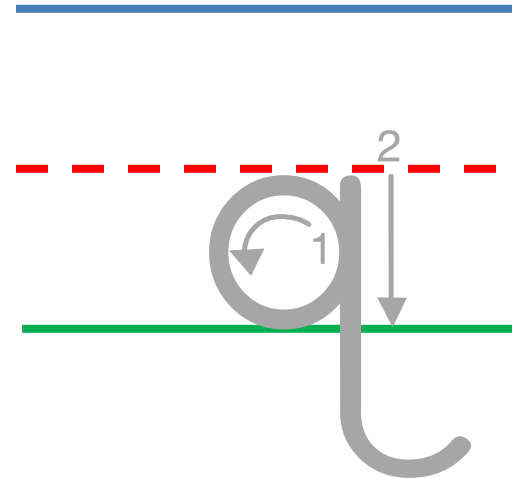
Start in the middle and
Make a long line down.
Go back to the middle
And circle half-way
around.



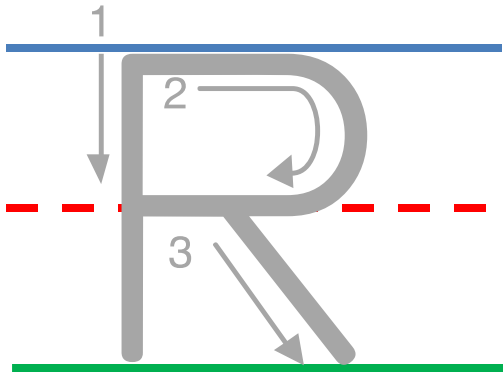
Capital Q starts like O,
Nice and fat and round
But add a little stand-up
Stick just so it won't fall
Down..



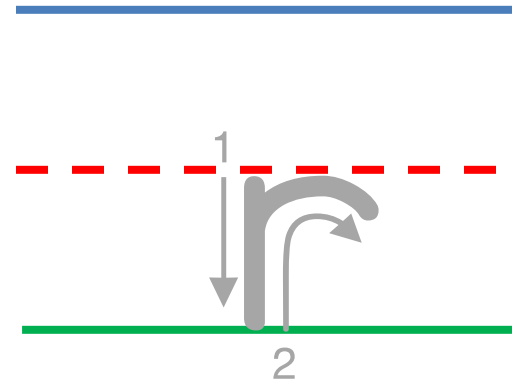
Start small q with a
Circle.
Make it very stout.
Then don't forget to
add a tail and curl it
down and out.



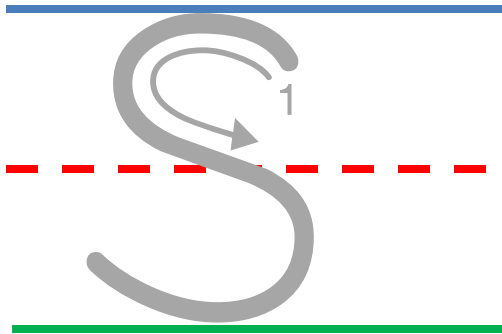
Make a line down,
Straight and tall.
Curve around to the
Middle.
A short line out,
That's all!



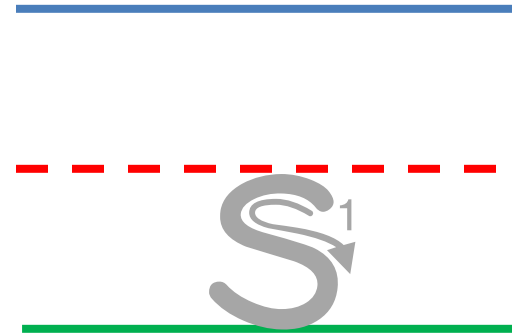
:Letter r is small.
Start in the middle with
A short line.
Curve at the top, that's
All.



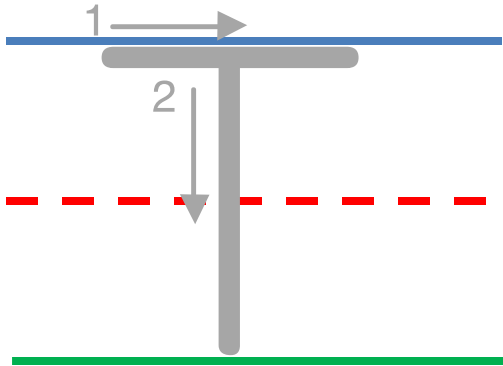
S looks like a snake,
Curve left then right.
From top to bottom,
Makes it right.



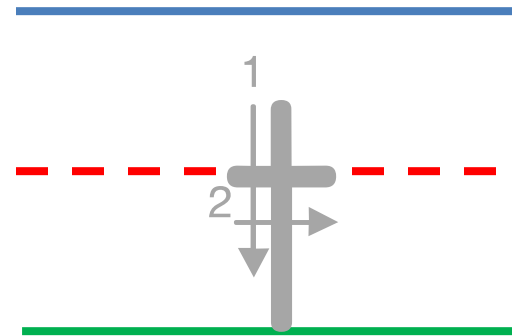
Small s looks like a
Snake, too. Curve
Left then right, that's
All you do.



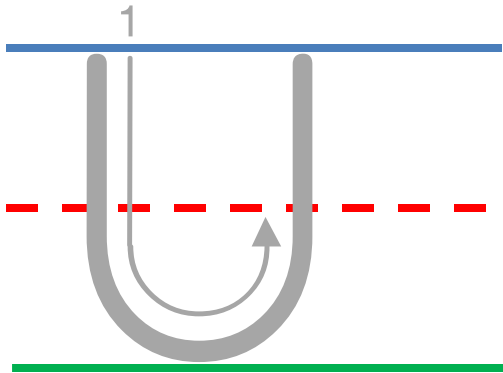
A long line down
begins the T.
Draw a straight line
Across and T it
Will be.



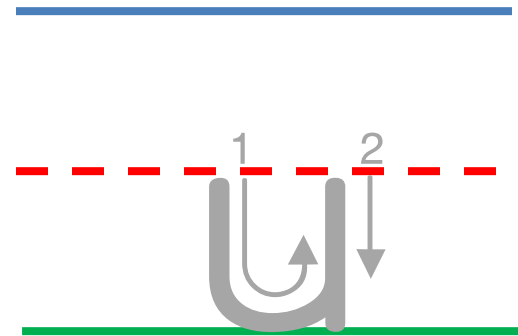
Not as tall, straight
Down for small t.
Cross near the middle,
A t you'll see.



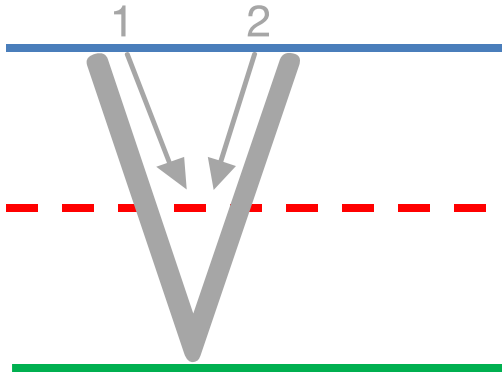
Make a straight line
Down that you start
From the top.
Curve around at the
Bottom, back up and
Then stop.



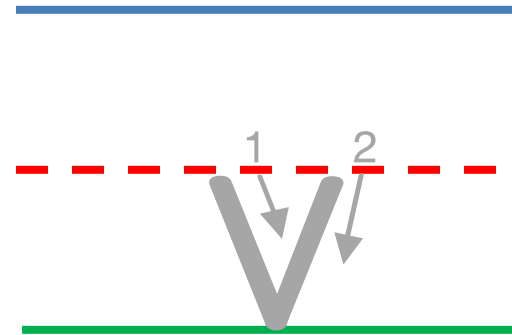
Start in the middle, go
Down and around.
Back up to the top,
Then a straight line
Down.



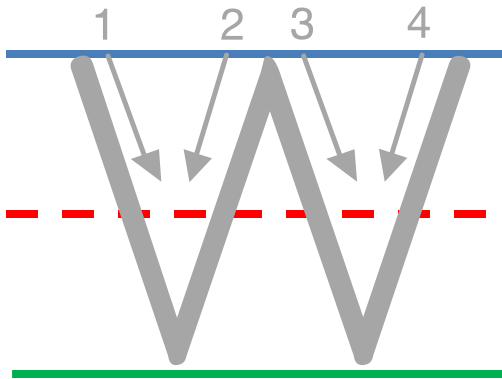
Start at the top.
Slant in just a little.
Back up to the top.
Away from the middle.



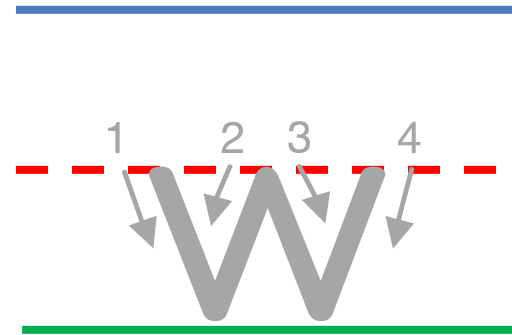
Little v's lines still meet
In the middle.
It's just like the capital,
Only it's little.



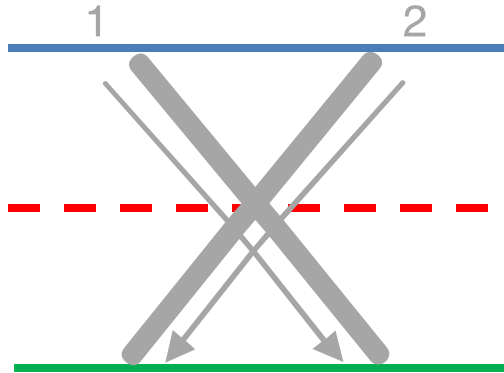
Four tall, straight lines
Make a capital W.
Start high, come down,
Go up, then back.
Now one more
Stroke, and you're
Right on track.



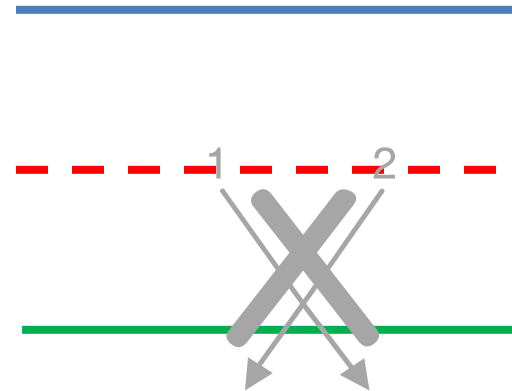
Small w looks like
Its great big brother.
Down once, go up,
Down once again.
Now finish it off and
Go up at the end.



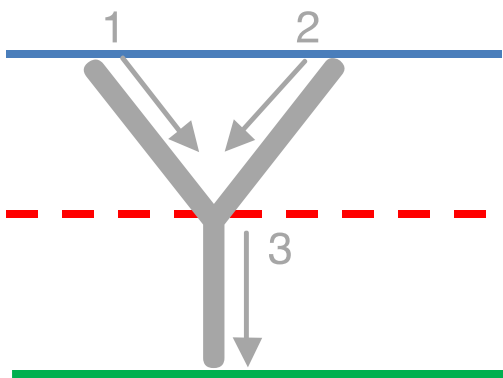
Tall line leans like a
Slanted stick.
Another line crosses
Quick, quick, quick!



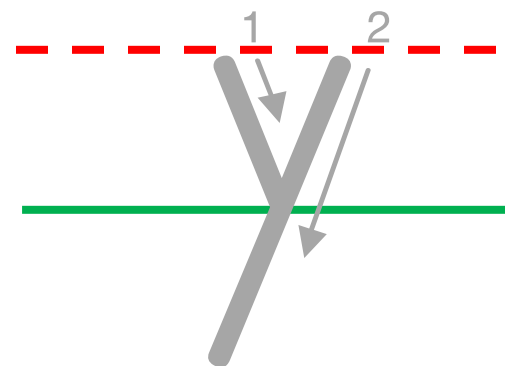
Little x isn't hard to do

Too.



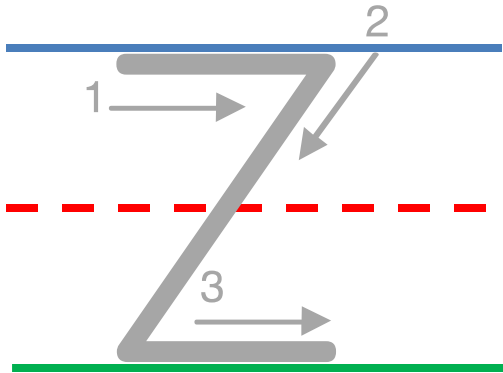
Start at the top line.
Halfway down to the
Middle.

Middle line.
Then bring down its
Tail, and your y will be

From the top, zip right
With a line.
Slant down to the left,
and zip right one more
time.
It's a Z, big Z, big Z.



From the middle, zip
Right with a line.
Slant down to the left,
And zip right one more
Time:
It's a z, a small z,
a small z!
